DIT University has not once failed to encourage its students on becoming active agents in developing environmental safety measures. Our Vice Chancellor Dr. K.K. Raina

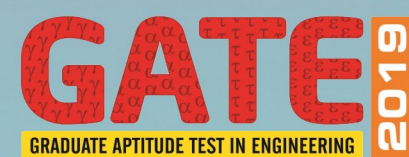

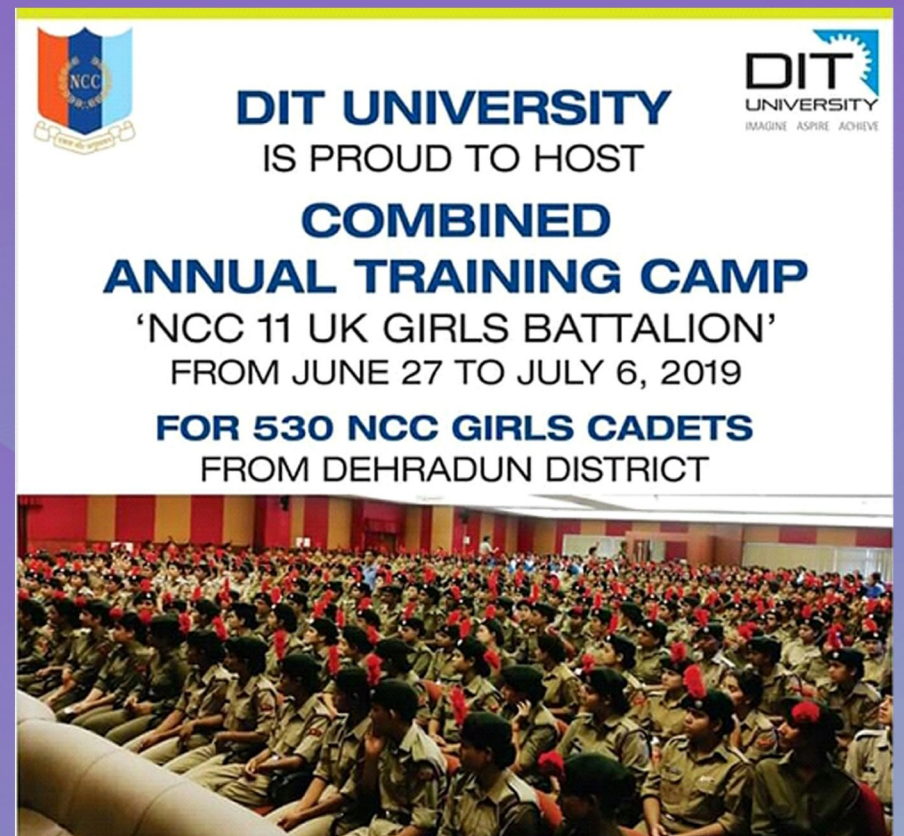
